If your dancer chooses not to participate after being selected for any of our levels, it can be unfair to everyone involved, as that opportunity could have been extended to another dancer. Please discuss the importance of commitment with your dancer and emphasize the significance of following through.

Company members are required to audition every year for the new season. During the year, company members take weekly technique classes, rehearse, and perform at various competitions, conventions and community events.

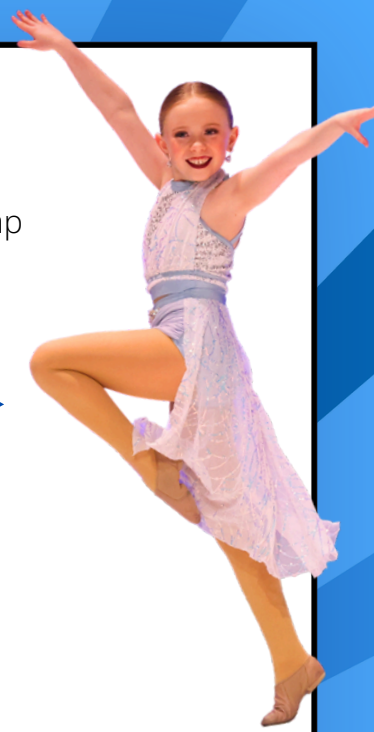
### **\*\*IHSA Compliant Option for High School Dance Team Members:\*\***

We offer an option for High School Dance Team members that allow them to still be part of our studio dance company AND comply with IHSA rules - as well as the limited time they have with academics and dance team.

We want our dancers who've grown with us to continue to be a part of their studio family once they start high school. We have trained them to be the dancers and performers they are today, and we want them to continue that training (and FUN!) with VDC through to their senior year.

Dancers also have the option of competing a solo, duo, or trio. If they would like to be in more than two routines, please let us know and we will work with them to see what we can do to make it happen.

# AUDITION DATE

**Ages 5-7: 3:30-4:15pm**  
**Ages 8-10: 4:30-5:30pm**  
**Ages 11-12: 5:45-6:45pm**  
**Ages 13-15: 7:00-8:00pm**  
**Ages 16+: 8:15-9:15pm**



***NOTE:** Please arrive 10-15 minutes early to get signed in and warmed up. We recommend parents of dancers age 5-7 come inside to get them checked in. For all other levels, you can leave once they've safely been walked to the entrance. Once inside, we will have one of our staff to direct them where to put their things and get them checked in and ready for their audition!*

**WHAT TO WEAR:** Girls should wear jazz shorts or leggings and a very fitted dance top, crop top, sports bra or leotard. Boys please wear pants or shorts and a tank/t-shirt. *No baggy t-shirts and/or baggy tank tops or bottoms for any dancers.* Everyone should wear jazz shoes for the audition. Please be sure your hair is pulled up and away from your face.

All dancers submitting after 6/27 may incur a late fee. No exceptions will be made.

***AUDITION PLACEMENTS ARE FINAL.** If your dancer is selected for company, their placement will be determined based on their skill level, technique, experience, and stage presence. Questioning your child's placement will not alter our decision. As dance educators, we understand the necessary skills and techniques required for specific routines. It is not only unfair to place a child in an inappropriate level but also unjust to the other dancers and the choreographer. If a dancer possesses the skills necessary for a particular level or company routine, there is no reason they wouldn't be placed there. They either have the skills or they do not.*



# Audition Process

All dancers wishing to audition for VDC will be required to attend the audition within their appropriate age groups (*age as of September 1, 2026*). Dancers will be evaluated on their technique during the audition. During this time, dancers will be taught a short, center floor jazz combination and perform it in smaller groups.

To help the dancers memorize the jazz combination, a video link will be posted on the Company page on our website by the evening of Monday July 6, 2026. We will provide a demonstration of the jazz combo with music. All dancers **MUST** remember and practice the jazz combination for auditions.

## AUDITION FEES:

- Current 2025-2026 Versafied Dance Company Members (*Periwinkle, Sky Blue, Teal, Turquoise, Cobalt, Sapphire*) may audition for no charge.
- Current VERSA5 dancers are required to pay a non-refundable \$25 fee.
- Non-VERSA5 dancers are required to pay a non-refundable \$50 fee.
